1.0 Background

The Hon'ble Supreme Court matter of Paryavaran Suraksha Samiti & Anr. v/s Union of India & Ors. (WP(C)-375 of 2012) was taken up by the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, Principal Bench, Delhi in OA No. 593 of 2017, in furtherance to the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 22.02.2017. The matter was last heard by Hon'ble NGT on 03rd August, 2018 and orders were passed. The Hon'ble NGT has stated that this matter requires continuous monitoring by statutory authorities and passed following orders:

- i. We direct the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) to forthwith prepare an action plan after looking into all the status reports. The action plans must have mechanism to ensure compliance or all the directions in the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court. To enable this to be done, a Nodal officer must be identified to deal with the issue of CETPs/ETPs/STPs.*
- ii. A representative of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change may be associated with the Nodal Officer of the CETP for monitoring. The Monitoring by the said two officers- the representative of the MoEFCC and the Nodal Officer of the CPCB must be held at least once in a month and on the basis of such meeting and the feedback taken, appropriate directions issued. This process may be a continuous process.*
- iii. It must be ensured that STPs, CETPs and ETPs are functional and meet the requisite standards.*
- iv. There is already a direction in the above judgment under which 50% of the funds for the purpose are to be provided by the Central Government, 25% by the States and remaining 25% to be arranged by way of loans which is to be re-paid by the user industries. Local bodies and the States have duties as clearly stipulated in the judgment. There has to be online monitoring system by each State to display emission levels in public domain in terms of paragraph 17 of the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.*
- v. A report of the steps taken may be placed on the website of the Central Pollution Control Board at least once in three months. Deficiencies if any may also be so displayed.*
- vi. The Central Pollution Control Board may take penal action for failure, if any, against those accountable for setting up and maintaining STPs, CETPs and ETPs. Central Pollution Control Board may also assess and recover compensation for damage to the environment and the said fund be kept in a separate account and utilized in terms of an action plan for protection of the environment. Such action plan may be prepared by the Central Pollution Control Board within three months from today.*
- vii. A compliance report in terms of the above order may be furnished to this Tribunal within four months from today by e-mail at filing.ngt@gmail.com.*

2.0 Constitution of Monitoring Committee

In compliance of the Hon'ble NGT Directions, the CPCB has nominated Shri Ajay Aggarwal, Scientist "E" as Nodal Officer to deal with the issue of CETPs/ETPs/STPs. The MoEF&CC has nominated Dr. (Ms.) Susan George K., Scientist "D" as a representative, associated with the Nodal Officer for monitoring.

3.0 Meetings of the Monitoring Committee

So far, six meetings of the Monitoring Committee were held on 24th August, 2018, 24th September, 2018, 26th October, 2018, 26th November, 2018, 21st December, 2018 and 22nd January, 2019 at CPCB Head Office, Delhi.

4.0 Steps taken by CPCB for compliance of the Hon'ble NGT order dated 03.08.2018

- i. CPCB has been conducting monthly meeting of the Monitoring Committee on regular basis.
- ii. CPCB has circulated the formats to all SPCBs/PCCs through letter dated 30.08.2018 for furnishing the compliance status reports for ETPs/CETPs/STPs by 10th of every month.
- iii. CPCB has interacted with SPCBs/PCCs in Review Meeting through video conferencing held on 28.08.2018, 25.10.2018 and 15.11.2018 for ensuring the compliance of the Hon'ble NGT Order dated 03.08.2018.
- iv. CPCB has sent reminder letters dated 12.10.2018, 26.10.2018, 18.12.2018, and 17.01.2019 to concerned SPCBs/PCCs, which have not furnished the compliance status reports to the Monitoring Committee.
- v. CPCB has prepared Action Plan for SPCBs/PCCs for ensuring the compliance of the Hon'ble NGT Order dated 03.08.2018 in the Matter of Paryavaran Suraksha Samiti & Anr. v/s Union of India & Ors. (OA No. 593/2017) for implementation by SPCBs/PCCs and circulated the same to all SPCBs/PCCs on 12.10.2018.
- vi. CPCB has analysed the status reports for the month of August, September, October, November and December 2018, received from the SPCBs/PCCs and communicated the shortcomings observed in the report to the concerned SPCB/PCC through letters dated 12.10.2018, 26.10.2018, 16.11.2018, 02.01.2018 and 23.01.2018.
- vii. CPCB has developed an online portal for submission of compliance status reports by SPCBs/PCCs. The details of the portal have been communicated through letter dated 26.10.2018 and video conferencing held on 25.10.2018 & 15.11.2018.
- viii. CPCB uploaded the first report of steps taken on its website, as directed by the Hon'ble Tribunal. (Web link http://cpcb.nic.in/NGT/Steps_Report_OANO593.pdf) on 02/11/2018.
- ix. CPCB has e-filed compliance status report in the matter of OA 593/2017 in the Hon'ble NGT on 28.11.2018 and revised report on 12.12.2018.
- x. The Chairman, CPCB constituted a Committee to deliberate on the issue of "Methodology for Assessing Penalty & Environmental Compensation and Action Plan to Utilize the Fund". The Committee has prepared the policy and placed in the Board Meeting of CPCB on 23.10.2018. The Board accorded the approval for submitting the Report/Guidelines to the Hon'ble NGT for appropriate order. CPCB has submitted the 'Methodology for Assessing Environmental Compensation and Action Plan to Utilize the Fund' to the Hon'ble NGT.

5.0 Compliance Status of ETPs/CETPs/STPs reported by SPCBs/PCCs:

As on 23.01.2019, the compliance status reports for ETPs/CETPs/STPs were received from 28 SPCBs/PCCs namely- Andhra Pradesh, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Chandigarh, Meghalaya, Puducherry, Tamil Nadu, Jammu & Kashmir, Tripura, Telangana, Punjab, Bihar, Nagaland, Sikkim, Chhattisgarh, Daman & Diu, Dadra Nagar Haveli, Goa, Arunachal Pradesh, West Bengal Madhya Pradesh, Kerala, Odisha, Himachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Karnataka, Maharashtra, Rajasthan and Gujarat. However, no such compliance status reports were received from 08 SPCBs/PCCs, namely, Assam, Delhi, Haryana, Jharkhand, Lakshadweep, Manipur, Uttarakhand and Uttar Pradesh. The status of monthly compliance reports received from SPCBs/PCCs is given at **Annexure-I**.

The information received from the 28 SPCBs/PCCs were analysed and the shortcomings observed were communicated to concerned SPCBs/PCCs for rectification. The shortcomings are related to mismatching of numbers of defaulter units and respective actions taken, non-furnishing the list of defaulter units, non-furnishing of targets dates of the completion of proposed/under construction CETPs/STPs, non-availability/non-operational web links for OCEMS data display, etc.

As per the action plan, the SPCBs/PCCs have been categorically requested to expedite the actions against the defaulting units. Subsequently, updated/corrected information were received from 13 SPCBs/PCCs, namely- Kerala, Nagaland, Chhattisgarh, Tamil Nadu, Jammu and Kashmir, Meghalaya, Tripura, Puducherry, Maharashtra, Goa, Odisha, Madhya Pradesh and Daman & Diu.

The state-wise summary of the compliance status based on the information received from SPCBs/PCCs is as follows:

- i. As per the information received from 28 SPCBs/PCCs, out of total 54091 number of industries requiring ETPs, 53109 industries are operating with functional ETPs and 981 industries are operating without ETPs. Show-cause notices and closure directions have been issued to 356 and 495 industries respectively for operating without ETPs. Legal cases have been filed against 4 industries and action is under process for 99 industries. Out of 53109 operational industries, 52047 industries are complying with environmental standards and 1062 industries are non-complying. Show-cause notices and closure directions have been issued to 610 and 242 industries respectively for non-compliance. Legal cases have been filed against 9 industries and action is under process for 201 industries (**Annexure-II**). Month-wise number of water polluting industries, inspected by SPCBs/PCCs for compliance verification is given at **Annexure-III**.
- ii. As per the information received from 28 SPCBs/PCCs, there are total 144 CETPs, out of which 106 CETPs are complying with environmental standards and 36 CETPs are non-complying. Show-cause notices and closure directions have been issued to 20 and 2 CETPs respectively for non-compliance. Legal cases have been filed against 10 CETPs and action is under process for 12 CETPs (**Annexure-IV**). Month-wise number of CETPs, inspected by SPCBs/PCCs for compliance verification is given at **Annexure-V**.
- iii. As per the information received from 28 SPCBs/PCCs, there are total 6565 STPs, out of which, 6180 STPs are complying with environmental standards and 426 STPs are non-complying. Show-cause notices and closure directions have been issued to 256 and 08 STPs respectively for non-compliance. Legal cases have been filed against 15 STPs and action is under process for 100 STPs (**Annexure-VI**). Month-wise number of CETPs, inspected by SPCBs/PCCs for compliance verification is given at **Annexure-VII**.
- iv. As per the information received from 28 SPCBs/PCCs, there are 50 CETPs and 456 STPs in construction/proposal stage. The state-wise details are provided at **Annexure-VIII**.
- v. As per the information received from 28 SPCBs/PCCs, only 6 SPCBs/PCCs namely- Himachal Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Meghalaya, Punjab, Telangana and West Bengal are displaying OCEMS data in public domain. The links provided by Kerala, Mizoram, Odisha, Tripura and Maharashtra are password protected and data is not available in public domain. Andhra Pradesh, Goa, Gujarat, Haryana, Jammu and Kashmir and Tamil Nadu have not provided appropriate web links (**Annexure-IX**).
