OFFICE ORDER

The Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) with the objective to streamline the procedure relating to installation and ensuring connectivity of on-line effluent and emission monitoring devices, series of instructions have been issued vide Orders dated 14.09.2016, 21.09.2016, 22.09.2016, 30.09.2016, 21.11.2016, 27.12.2016;

The last circular (dated 27.12.2016) was relating to completion of installation and connectivity by industries before 28.02.2017 provided the industry has been reported to be complying with the standards and possessing valid consent. In furtherance, it is to convey that wherever installation of on-line devices is completed but, connectivity is not made by such units, the final time line to secure connectivity of such industries is 31.01.2017 and failing to comply these deadlines, the actions shall follow.

OFFICE ORDER

(Regarding Inspections, Follow-ups & revoking of OCEMS closure directions)

In continuation of the Office order no. B-29012/2014-15/ESS dated 11.12.2015 and O/o of even number dated September 14, 2016 regarding Inspections and follow ups and Office Memoranda dated 21.09.2016, 22.09.2016, 30.09.2016 and 21.11.2016 regarding revoking directions for online monitoring systems, the additional instructions and timelines, as detailed below shall be followed for considering the request for revoking of directions issued to industrial units u/s 5 of the E (P) Act, 1986 and exemption from OCEMS installation.

A. Revoking of directions for closure of manufacturing operations/restriction of production capacity (Other than OCEMS cases);


1. The request received from the industrial units for revoking of closure order/reinstating production capacity, indicating **complete compliance** to the directions given by CPCB shall be forwarded for verification to the concerned Zonal Office within **05 days** from the date of receipt by the concerned divisions.
2. The Zonal Office shall carry out the inspection and submit a point wise compliance report, complete in all aspects, with clear cut recommendations regarding revoking of closure/reinstating of production capacity to the HO within **21 days** of receipt of such request from H.O.
3. The inspection team shall also verify the compliance to **closure of manufacturing operations/restriction of production capacity** with documentary evidence. The procedure for carrying out inspections and preparation of inspection reports shall be the same as detailed in the earlier office order.
4. Inspections that are to be carried out by divisions at HO shall also be completed including submission of reports within **21 days** of receiving such requests from industrial units.
5. The processing division shall put up the file with suitable proposal of action before the Chairman, CPCB within **07 days** of receipt of Inspection reports.

B. Request for exemption from installation of OCEMS:

The requests for exemption for 17 categories of highly polluting industries and Grossly Polluting Industries (Ganga) shall be governed in following cases:

- a. Units connected with CETPs will require to install only flow meters and web camera.
- b. Stand-alone units having quantity of flow of effluent <10KLD or having intermittent discharges; will have to install flow meter and web camera and such units shall declare schedule/ timings of treated effluent discharge and such cases be reflected in their consent.
- c. In both a and b above, industries shall have valid Consent from SPCB and also shall submit effluent sample analysis report from any EPA approved laboratory.

The above instructions are being issued with the approval of the Chairman, CPCB and shall be strictly followed by the Zonal Offices and the concerned divisions/Nodal officers at Head Office.
